Dear Friend of the European Union,

The University of East Anglia announced in september 2013 that life on our planet can not last for more than another 1 750 000 000 years because of activities of the sun.

In that perspective of time the world population of today due to consumption and pollution must be reduced. May be to 1/30. This is possible with 1-child policy for 5 generations.

Professor Garrett Hardin concluded in "Living within limits: Ecology, economics and population taboos" (1993) and in "The ostrich factor" (1999) that a reduction of the global population is a necessity and therefore it would no more be possible with unrestricted migration. No state can tolerate sabotage of its efforts to reduce its own number of inhabitants.

The Scania Party, for which I am chairman, has the opinion, that the establishing of the European Union is the best that has happened to Europe since the Roman Empire. If the EU had existed in 1910 and remained in force we had not got the World War I, the Russian Revolution, the World War II, the Holocaust etc.

Of course, the EU must go on and expand. Within some years, probably already within 20 years, there will be a worldwide need for the EU to manage the world population problem. During this period and even later people can not be allowed to cross state borders free. Professor Hardin has explained the reasons.

Thus the right for people to cross the borders also within the EU must be excluded from the "four freedoms" of the EU. Since the population problem will force the EU to this exclusion within some years, why not deliberately banish this freedom immediately? Then the EU ought to be transformed to a global union "GU".

My partymembers and I observe a real tragedy when we see the EU collapse as a result of a simple mistake. The EU problem of today can easily be solved by reinforcement of person border controls which anyhow will be introduced later but then for other reasons, population reasons.

Perhaps a new Brexit referendum will give the opposite result if it was held on the assumption that free border crossing for people not longer was permitted?

Finally I have a question to you. Which person do you think would be the best one to suggest that the EU constitution no longer can include the right for people to settle in other EU member states without permission?
